COMMITTEES

Caring for America

This committee presents a monthly service project to the membership that will benefit our local Mount Vernon and Franconia service organizations. Plans and organizes a monthly service project that all members can participate in. Projects include volunteerism and food, clothing or monetary collections from club members.

Hospitality

This committee provides organized food and beverage coordination and acts as a secondary group of greeters to be welcoming and inclusive to all members and guests. Coordinates and organizes refreshments and other items for the entire club including set up and clean up. Keeps inventory of paper goods & replaces as necessary and keeps receipts for reimbursement.

Nominations

This committee works throughout the year to identify and retain the most capable people among our membership for the officers in Colonial Mount Vernon Republican Women. Recruitment process begins in August/September and in October the slate is presented to the club. Coordinates with the outgoing officers, provides materials and task lists for the education and training of the new officers.

Political Action

This committee engages our membership on key issues impacting our families, schools and communities in order to spread awareness and educate our membership on the limited role of government. Provides updates on Fairfax GOP and State GOP sharing their events and volunteer needs. Coordinates an effort of letter writing or emailing our elective officials regarding key votes and other issues.

Scholarship

This committee engages with secondary schools including private, parochial and government schools in the Mount Vernon and Franconia Districts in search of students to participate in our Scholarship Essay Program. The committee selects an essay topic and evaluates all submitted essays. Interviews are set up with finalists to assess their academic ability and spot IA composition.

Chili Cook-Off

This committee organizes our annual Chili Cook-off fundraiser where the proceeds are used to support local candidates. Coordinates and organizes the chili competition. Solicits donations for chili entries and other food and drinks, maintains and updates the task lists for the event.

Farmers Markets

This committee organizes volunteers to set up, man, and breakdown the Fairfax GOP red tent at the Sherwood Hall Farmers Market, every Wednesday (May – Oct) from 8am-12pm. **Future plans – to include the Lorton Station Farmers Market, Sundays from 8am-12pm**
